

The Lifelenz Prize

PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This non-endowed prize has been established by the University as a result of a 2018 contribution by Lifelenz for the purpose of establishing a prize in Software Engineering.

In support of the prize Lifelenz shall provide to the University \$750.00 (GST free).

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$750.00 per year.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the prize students must be enrolled in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Software) degree program.

Selection of Candidate

The Head of the School of Computer Science will award the prize to the final year Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Software) student who has successfully completed all the requirements for the program and has achieved the highest Honours mark.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
