

Best Ingenuity Petroleum Engineering Project Australian School of Petroleum

PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This Prize has been established by the Australian School of Petroleum to recognise quality project presentation and extensive audience engagement at the annual 'Ingenuity' event in the area of Petroleum Engineering.

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500 per year which will be divided equally between the recipients (if applicable), funded by the Australian School of Petroleum.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students enrolled in one of the following programs, either in level 4 or level 5 of their final year degree.

Bachelor of Engineering (Honours)(Petroleum)
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours)(Petroleum) with Bachelor of Science
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours)(Petroleum) with Chemical Engineering
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours)(Petroleum) with Civil Engineering
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours)(Petroleum) with Mechanical Engineering
Bachelor of Engineering (Honours)(Petroleum) with Mining Engineering

Selection of Candidate

The Head of The Australian School of Petroleum or nominee will award the prize to the student or group of students who are deemed to deliver the best project presentation at the annual 'Ingenuity' event, based on visual presentation (poster and display) and audience engagement at the time of judging.

If there is no candidates of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year.

If there is more than one group of candidates of equal merit, then the prize may be shared equally between the recipients in each group.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
