This Prize has been established by a donation to the University by Landmark Operations Ltd, a leading agribusiness company, who wish to support the University by establishing a prize for the benefit of students in the Bachelor of Agricultural Sciences that encourages them towards a career in agronomy.

The value of the Prize will be \$3,000 and up to 12 weeks work experience with Landmark Operations Pty Ltd for Professional Skills in Agricultural Sciences usually at the end of their second year or prior to going into the last year of their degree (in the summer period and negotiated with the student for up to 12 weeks). The internship will count towards the student's work experience course requirement.

Eligibility

The Prize is awarded by the University annually to a student in the Bachelor of Agricultural Sciences who has successfully completed at least their first year of studies or equivalent.

Candidate Selection

Selection of the prize will be made jointly by Landmark Operations Limited and the Program Coordinator of the Bachelor of Agricultural Sciences. The selection panel will include the donor. Applications will be assessed on academic merit, interview and demonstrated interest by the student in sales agronomy.
