Eligibility

Student who has completed the first year of the Masters in Biotechnology (Plant Biotechnology).

Candidate Selection

The award of up to \$1000 will be awarded to the female student who has achieved the highest cumulative GPA in the first year of the Master of Biotechnology (Plant Biotechnology) program.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the award will not be presented in that year.
