Prize rule

Value

The value of the prize shall be \$400, or such other amount as the University may from time to time determine provided that the value does not exceed the annual income distribution available from the Endowment Fund.

Eligibility

Undergraduate student in the Bachelor of Agricultural Sciences.

Candidate Selection

Awarded to the best student in plant pathology who is of sufficient merit as decided by the Discipline Head.

If in any year the Program Coordinator (or nominee) of the School of Agriculture, Food & Wine considers that no candidate is of sufficient merit no award shall be made and the monies that would have been awarded in that year shall be added to the capital sum in the Endowment Fund.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the University's legal obligations and policies.
