## Prize rule

### Value

The value of the Prize will be \$5,000 per year for three years (2018, 2019, 2020) until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the donor.

### Eligibility

The Prize is awarded by the University annually and on the following eligibility criteria:-

- for students undertaking 3rd year of the Bachelor of Viticulture and Oenology

### Candidate Selection

The Head of School or his / her nominee will award the Prize to the student achieving the best aggregate grade for the 4 courses undertaken in Semester 1:

1. Winemaking at Vintage;
2. Stabilisation and Clarification III;
3. Plant Health III;
4. Viticultural Science III.

and who shows the greatest aptitude for winemaking in the opinions of the teaching staff.

This Prize will also come with the opportunity to undertake a paid vintage position at a Casella's winery at the commencement of the 4th year of study.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in any given year then the Prize will not be awarded in that year and the funds may be used in subsequent years.

### Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the University's legal obligations and policies.
