## Faculty of Sciences criteria for outstanding academic progress

Faculty of Sciences coursework students, who achieve a 'Year' GPA  $\geq 5.950$  and have attempted a minimum of 12 units of study during the year, will receive a letter of commendation from the Executive Dean of Sciences for Outstanding Academic Achievement.
