Enrolment Advice

- It is your responsibility to ensure you are correctly enrolled. Enrolment into courses outside of the Study Plan and Enrolment Advice listed could affect your eligibility to graduate.
- A total of 72 units are required to complete the Bachelor of Liberal Arts & Science program.
- Level I courses not exceeding 30 units.
- Level III courses to the value of 24 units.
- Core courses to the value of 33 units.
- Open electives to the value of 39 units, which must include at least 18 units from the Faculty of Sciences and at least 18 units from the Faculty of Arts OR refer to your [program rules](#) for rules on presenting an Arts or Science major or an Arts minor.
- In the case of a major or minor in Indigenous Knowledges and Society, students will be required to undertake an additional course to the value of 3 units in lieu of ABORIG 1002 Indigenous Scholarship & Interplay of Knowledges.
