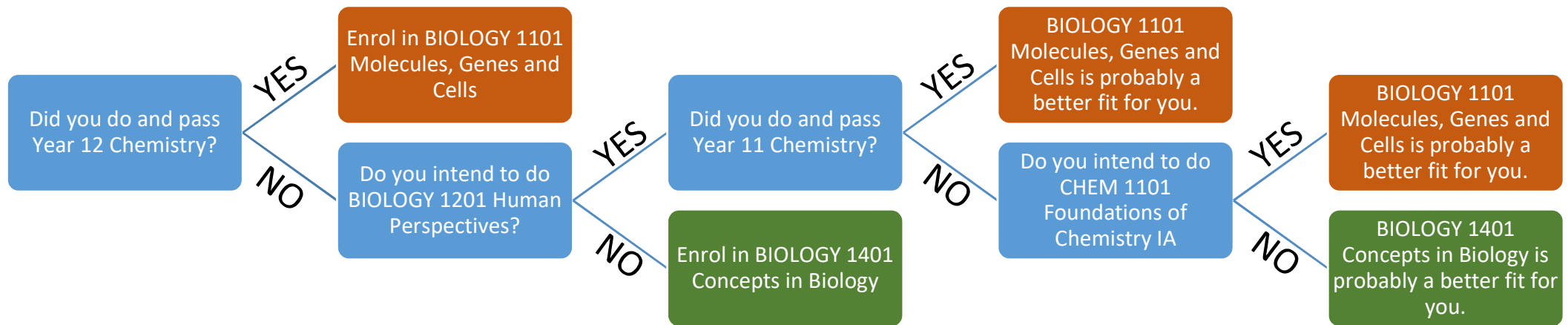


# Which Semester 1 BIOLOGY course is appropriate for me?

BIOLOGY 1401 Concepts in Biology

OR

BIOLOGY 1101 Molecules, Genes and Cells\*



**BIOLOGY 1101 Molecules, Genes and Cells** (called MGC) has a greater chemistry focus than BIOLOGY 1401 Concepts in Biology. Students realise this right from the beginning, because the very first topic of MGC has the most chemistry, and at least two-thirds of MGC is about biological molecules, including functional groups, bonds and interactions.

**BIOLOGY 1401 Concepts in Biology** (called CiB) covers the molecular concepts of MGC but in less detail/depth. CiB is designed for students without a chemistry background. It is OK to go from CiB into the Semester 2 course BIOLOGY 1201 Human Perspectives, but MGC is actually better preparation (and also better preparation for Level 2 BIOCHEM/GENETICS/MICRO courses).
