

The Codan Radio Communications RF Engineering Achievement Prize PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This Prize has been established by the University as a result of a contribution by Codan Limited.

In support of the prize Codan Limited shall provide to the University as result of a pledge request, an annual amount equivalent to \$500.00 (GST free).

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500.00 per year for 5 years or until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded by the University annually and is open to students undertaking the Level <u>III-IV</u> course: ELEC ENG <u>43106</u> RF Engineering.

Selection of Candidate

The Head of the School of Electrical and Electronic Engineering or nominee will award the prize to the student who obtains the best overall result in the assessment of the Level HIV course ELEC ENG 43106 RF Engineering.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
