



Physics Bridging Course Terms and Conditions

1. The University of Adelaide (“University”) offers the Physics Bridging Course (“the Course”) on the terms and conditions set out below.
2. The Course is recognised by the University as the equivalent of SACE Stage 2 Physics for the purposes of admission into a University degree.
 - a. The Course is an intensive online course designed for students who have completed SACE Stage 1 Physics (or equivalent) but did not go on to complete SACE Stage 2 Physics.
 - b. To be eligible for the Course you must have completed SACE Stage 1 Physics (or equivalent). By purchasing a place on the Course you warrant that you have completed SACE Stage 1 Physics (or equivalent).
 - c. The Course cannot be counted towards your high school completion and cannot contribute towards your ATAR.
 - d. The Course does not provide direct admission into a degree. You will still need to submit a formal application for admission, and meet all of the degree’s other entry requirements, including (but not limited to) the minimum academic score, other prerequisite subjects and any additional requirements (questionnaire, interview etc.).
 - e. The Course has been designed to be completed over 10 weeks, with a minimum time commitment of 90 hours of work to complete the core content. The Course is structured in modules with on-demand mini-lectures, video tutorials of physics principles and worked examples of problems. Assessment is completed by a mix of quizzes, assignments, reports and tests.
 - f. You must successfully complete the Course for it to be recognised by the University for the purposes of admission into a University degree.
3. To enrol in the Course, you must purchase a place on the Course via the University’s online shop.
 - a. The price of the Course is \$790. Partial payments, FEE-HELP or HECS-HELP are not available.
 - b. By purchasing a place in the Course, you confirm that you have read, understood and accept these terms and conditions.
 - c. Payment for the Physics Bridging Course must be made in full prior to the commencement of the course. The available methods of payment for the Physics Bridging Course include:

 - Visa
 - d. Confirmation of purchase will be provided in writing via the email address supplied by you at checkout.
 - e. You must provide accurate and complete details when purchasing your place in the Course. The information you provide during the purchase process will be used and handled in accordance with the [University’s Privacy Policy](#).



- f. The University will not be liable if details provided by you are inaccurate or incomplete. Refunds will not be issued for failure to provide accurate / complete details during the purchase process.
4. The University reserves the right to cancel a Course, at any time and for any reason. If the University cancels a course prior to commencement, you will be notified in a timely manner and offered a transfer to another instance of the same Course. If you do not accept the Course transfer offered and if payment has already been received, a full refund will be provided.
5. If you notify the University of your withdrawal from the Course and payment has already been received, the University may at its absolute discretion offer you a part or full refund, or no refund.
6. In undertaking the Course, you agree to be bound by the University's policies, including but not limited to policies regarding behaviour and conduct, and academic honesty. Breaches of the University's policies may result in you being removed from the Course.
